It won't have escaped your notice that there's a new Pope. We echo the prayers of Archbishop Stephen for His Holiness Pope Leo and for our Roman Catholic sisters and brothers at the start of a new Papacy. Previously, Pope Leo was a member of the Order of St Augustine and we have that connection with him; from the 12th century until the Reformation, Carshalton was a daughter house of the Augustinian Canons of Merton Priory. Pray, too, for Fr Vincent Okon who was Inducted on Friday as the new Parochial Administrator of Holy Cross, on secondment from his Diocese in Nigeria.
