## Financial Donations

The **PARISH GIVING SCHEME** ([www.parishgiving.org.uk](http://www.parishgiving.org.uk)). We are part of this scheme and a good number of folk have already joined; thank you. The PCC receives a lump sum payment each month, including any Gift Aid claimed for the month, which helps hugely with our monthly cash flow. The staff at PGS are very helpful with setting it up - you are able to set the amount for each month and, if a UK taxpayer, sign up for Gift Aid, which is claimed for us by them each month,

**STANDING ORDER**, which can set up through [www.carshaltonallsaints.org](http://www.carshaltonallsaints.org); if you do this, please do complete and sign a separate Gift Aid Declaration form and hand it in as we will have to collect the Gift Aid on these donations.

Either of the above helps to reduce our admin in banking cash, increases our cash flow and makes giving more efficient.
