*Please STAND. The President greets the people:*

My brothers and sisters,  
we gather for worship  
in the name of ✠ the Father,  
and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.  
**Amen.**

*The President introduces the Prayers of Penitence:*

The grace of God has dawned upon the world  
through our Saviour Jesus Christ,  
who sacrificed himself for us to purify a people as his own.  
Let us confess our sins.

***SILENT PRAYER***

***The President pronounces God's absolution:***

through Jesus Christ our Lord.  
**Amen.**

In silence, we pray.

***Silent prayer; then the President prays the Collect. At the end, all reply:***

**Amen**

# THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

*Please SIT for a reading from the Old or New Testament. At the end:*

For the word of the Lord.  
**Thanks be to God.**

*A Responsorial Psalm usually follows.*

*Then, please STAND for the Gospel, which is heralded by an acclamation (please sing the refrain).*



*The cantor sings the verse:*

Christ was revealed in flesh, proclaimed among the nations and believed in throughout the world.

*Repeat the refrain with the cantor:*



The Lord be with you.  
**And with thy spirit.**

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Saint *N*  
**✠ Glory be to thee, O Lord.**

*At the end*

This is the Gospel of the Lord.  
**Praise to thee, O Christ.**

***The President and/or others leads the Prayers of intercession, for which please SIT or KNEEL***

Let us worship the Saviour with joy  
and make our prayer to our heavenly Father.

***At the end***

We gather up these and all of our prayers  
in the company of the Blessed Mary, St Joseph and all the saints;  
Merciful Father,  
**accept these prayers for the sake of thy Son,  
our Saviour Jesus Christ.  
Amen.**

# THE LITURGY OF THE SACRAMENT

*The President introduces the Peace.*

Christ is our peace.  
If anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation.  
The old has passed away: behold, everything has become new.  
The Peace of the Lord be always with you.  
**And with thy spirit.**

*The altar is prepared and then the president takes the bread and the cup, saying either of the following:*

Word made flesh, life of the world, in your incarnation you embraced our poverty: by your Spirit may we share in your riches.  
**Amen.**

*or*

Open the heavens, Holy Spirit, for us to see Jesus interceding for us; may we be willing to share his baptism, ready to share his cup and strengthened to serve him for ever.  
**Amen.**

The Lord be with you  
**and with thy spirit.**

Lift up your hearts.  
**We lift them up unto the Lord.**

Let us give thanks unto the Lord our God.  
**It is meet and right so to do.**

*The President continues the prayer, thanking God for all his saving works, and then invites the people to join their praises with the whole company of heaven:*

(...forever praising you, and saying:)

**Holy, holy, holy, Lord God of hosts,  
heaven and earth are full of thy glory.  
Glory be to thee, O Lord most high.  
✠ Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.  
Hosanna in the highest.**

*The President continues the prayer, repeating the Lord's own words over the bread and wine and asks the Father to send the Spirit on them to sanctify them.*

**Then:**

Great is the mystery of faith:  
**Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.**

*The President continues, joining our offering with Christ's sacrifice of himself. At the end:*

Through Christ, and with Christ, and in Christ,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
all honour and glory are yours,  
O loving Father, for ever and ever.  
**Amen.**

***Please SIT or KNEEL.***

***Silent Prayer***

Believing the promises of God,  
let us pray with confidence as our Saviour has taught us:

**Our Father, who art in heaven,.....**

***The president breaks the consecrated bread for all to share:***

Every time we eat this bread and drink this cup,  
**we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.**

***We say Agnus Dei:***

**Jesus Lamb of God,  
have mercy on us.**

**Jesus, bearer of our sins,  
have mercy on us.**

**Jesus, redeemer of the world,  
grant us peace.**

***The president invites all to receive Holy Communion:***

Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.  
Blessed are those who are called to his supper.  
**Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldst come under my  
roof, but speak the word only and my soul shall be healed.**

***All taking part online are encouraged to make their Spiritual Communion, using  
the following prayer:***

Lord Jesus Christ,  
grant, that as the hem of your garment,  
touched in faith,  
healed the woman who could not touch your body,  
so the soul of your servant may be healed by faith in you,  
whom I cannot now sacramentally receive;  
through your tender mercy,  
who lives and reigns with the Father  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit ever one God,  
world without end.  
Amen.



# THE DISMISSAL

*The President prays the Post Communion prayer, then please STAND:*

The Lord be with you.

**And also with you.**

Christ the Son of God perfect in you the image of his glory  
and gladden your hearts with the good news of his kingdom;

✠ and the blessing of God almighty,  
the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit,  
be among you and remain with you  
this Epiphanytide and always.

**Amen.**

We have seen his glory, the glory revealed to all the nations.

Go in the peace of Christ.
