Tuesday 13 February : Parish Shrove Tuesday Party, from 1830. There are FREE tickets available via the website (so the clergy know roughly how many pancakes to make!); do book some and come along!

Wednesday 14 February : Ash Wednesday High Mass and Imposition of Ashes at 2000. The first day of Lent, this is a holy day of obligation and we are all encouraged to come along that evening.
