Choral music is an important part of our life at All Saints' - donations are gratefully received to support our Choristers and Choral Scholars.




Each Choral Scholar receives an annual scholarship of £900, and each Chorister (depending on attendance) receives approximately £60 annually.

### 'Voices from the past'

a historical look at All Saints' through the Ages

### Saturday afternoon, October 18<sup>th</sup> 2025, beginning at 2.30pm Tickets £10, online or on the door

In this afternoon series of five short (20 minute) illustrated talks about the long history of our church, local researchers will take you back to the ancient beginnings of worship here in the Dark Ages, then showing how the medieval building, which still gives much character to the present church, was developed over several centuries and finally, in the 20<sup>th</sup> century, the combination of a wealthy Rector with one of the greatest early 20<sup>th</sup> century designers of his day provided the resplendent decoration which dominates the church today.

There will also be a talk about one of the great unsung 17<sup>th</sup> century parishioners, commemorated by a monumental masterpiece of the baroque, and a look through the Vestry window at Parish life in the 17<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> centuries with its varied agenda including education, health, security and highway maintenance!

- 1) John Phillips Carshalton; the evidence (or not) for the Roman and Saxon origins of the building.
- 2) Richard Pocock The evolution of the fabric of the building during the medieval period.
- 3) Andrew Langley Henry Herringman; Citizen, Stationer and Parishioner, and his monument.
- Andrew Skelton 'Running the Parish; tales from the Vestry Books, 1670 -1830.'
- 5) Rev. David Fisher Making a Masterpiece; the partnership of the Rev. William Corbould and Sir Ninian Comper in the first half of the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

There will be a short interval of 20 minutes after the third talk. Refreshments will be available throughout as always.
