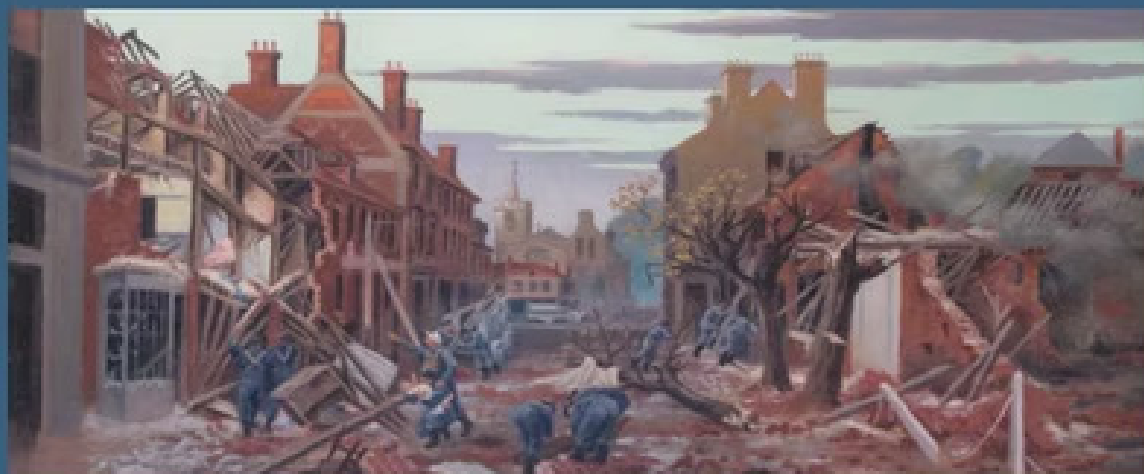


FIGHT FOR FREEDOM
