The staff at PGS are very helpful with setting it up - you are able to set the amount for each month and, if a UK taxpayer, sign up for Gift Aid, which is claimed for us by them each month,

Either of the above helps to reduce our admin in banking cash, increases our cash flow and makes giving more efficient.
