Choir development

The choir is now on a well-earned break for the summer. When they return, there'll be a 'front row' of children singing the treble line in the choir and we already have a group who are signed up for this. We're advertising it in the local Primary Schools in the parish and through Sutton Music Trust; but if you know of a child (Year 3 upwards) who likes singing and might be interested, do let Antony know.

We're also looking for further Choral Scholars; do spread the word and encourage applicants (and the posts for these are also out in schools!). *Equally, any gentlemen who sing Tenor or Bass, do have a word with Antony, who'd be delighted to hear from you.*

From September, Choir Practice will move to Thursday evenings, with the Juniors starting at 1900; the first one will be on Thursday 5 September.

Audio Visual update

The equipment for the new audio-visual system has arrived and it will be installed starting on 5 August. The updated sound system will be digital rather than analogue and will be much clearer and more reliable. For streaming of services, there will be three mobile cameras around church, enabling opportunity to 'close in' at appropriate parts of the liturgy.

The cameras will be controlled via a mixing desk, laptop and iPad; with the associated software, the total cost is £26,000; if you've already made a donation to help offset this amount, thank you! Further donations will be gratefully received!
