## **Audio Visual update**

The equipment for the new audio-visual system has arrived and it will be installed during the first week of August onwards. The updated sound system will be digital rather than analogue and will be much clearer and more reliable. For streaming of services, there will be three mobile cameras around church, enabling opportunity to 'close in' at appropriate parts of the liturgy.

The cameras will be controlled via a mixing desk, laptop and iPad; with the associated software, the total cost is £26,000; donations to offset this amount will be gratefully received!
