## **Advance Notices.....**

**Daily Office** : why not try and join the clergy in church for Morning or Evening Prayer as part of your Lenten discipline - even if only once or twice a week?....

**Wednesdays in Lent** : the clergy will be available in church 6-7pm each Wednesday evening for anyone who may wish to make their Confession.

**Fridays in Lent** : every Friday in Lent (apart from Good Friday), there will be Stations of the Cross at 1230. Lasting 30-40 minutes, this is a quiet and meditative service as we walk around the church with a prayer and meditation at each Station, reflecting on Christ's journey to the Cross.

**Study Groups** : the Ecumenical Study Groups have now started (but more information on them from Janice Funnell). Our weekly Bible Study group starts at 1930 this coming Thursday, in the Lady Chapel; we will examine the themes around the readings set for the Easter Vigil.

**World Day of Prayer** : this year, it will be this Friday, 1 March, and one of the local services will be here at All Saints, in the evening. More information from Janice Funnell, or see the posters on the website or in church; ALL very welcome!

**Mothering Sunday** : this year, it falls on 10 March - as usual, there will be ONE Mass at 1000, at which posies will be distributed.

# DAILY WORSHIP

**Morning Prayer** is Tuesday-Friday at 0830 (Chancel) and **Evening Prayer** is Tuesday, Thursday and Friday at 1730 (Lady Chapel), using the *Common Worship Daily Prayer* app (please use the North Door if attending). If you would like to attend either of the offices, please send the clergy a message so they know to unlock the door.

**Weekday Mass** is at 1000 on Tuesday, 1730 on Wednesday (both *Common Worship*) and 1000 on Thursday (*BCP*).
