# THE GATHERING

#### Please STAND. The President greets the people:

My brothers and sisters, we gather for worship in the name of ▼ the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Amen.

The Lord be with you.

And with thy spirit.

#### The President introduces the Prayers of Penitence:

Jesus says,

'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand.'

So let us turn away from sin and turn to Christ, confessing our sins in penitence and faith.

#### SILENT PRAYER

#### The President pronounces God's Absolution:

Almighty God, who forgives all who truly repent, have mercy upon you; 

♣ pardon and deliver you from all your sins, confirm and strengthen you in all goodness and keep you in life eternal; through Jesus Christ, our Lord. 
Amen.

In silence, we pray.

Silent prayer; then the President prays the Collect.

At the end, all reply:

Amen

# THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

#### Please SIT for a reading from the Old or New Testament. At the end:

For the word of the Lord.

Thanks be to God.

The Responsorial Psalm usually follows; then, please STAND for the Gospel, which is heralded by an acclamation.

#### Sing the refrain with the cantor:



#### The cantor sings the verse:

Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord. Peace in heaven and glory in the highest heaven.

#### Repeat the refrain with the cantor:



The Lord be with you.

And with your spirit.

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to N  $\blacksquare$  Glory be to thee, O Lord.

#### At the end

This is the Gospel of the Lord.

Praise be to thee, O Christ.

### Please SIT or KNEEL for the Prayers of Intercession

Let us with confidence present our prayers and supplications to the throne of grace.

#### At the end

We gather up these and all of our prayers in the company of Blessed Mary and all the saints. Merciful Father, accept these prayers for the sake of thy Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ.

Amen.

## THE LITURGY OF THE SACRAMENT

#### Please STAND as the President introduces the Peace.

May the God of peace sanctify you; may he so strengthen your hearts in holiness that you may be blameless before him at the coming of our Lord Jesus with his saints. The Peace of the Lord be always with you. **And with thy spirit.** 

We offer each other a sign of Christ's peace.

#### The altar is prepared and then the president takes the bread and the cup:

Blessed be God, who enthrones us with Christ in the heavenly realms. May we feed upon the bread of God and drink the royal wine of heaven.

Blessed be God for ever.

The Lord be with you and with thy spirit.
Lift up your hearts.
We lift them up unto the Lord.
Let us give thanks unto the Lord our God.
It is meet and right so to do.

The President continues the prayer, thanking God for all his saving works, and then invites the people to join their praises with the whole company of heaven:

(....forever praising you, and saying:)

Holy, holy, Lord God of hosts, heaven and earth are full of thy glory. Glory be to thee, O Lord most high.

▶ Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

The President continues the prayer, repeating the Lord's own words over the bread and wine and asks the Father to send the Spirit on them to sanctify them.

#### Then:

Great is the mystery of faith: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.

The President continues, joining our offering with Christ's sacrifice of himself. At the end:

Through Christ, and with Christ, and in Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honour and glory are yours, O loving Father, for ever and ever.

Amen.

#### Please either SIT or KNEEL. Silent Prayer

Uniting our prayers with the whole company of heaven, as our Saviour taught us, so we pray:

Our Father,
who art in heaven,
hallowed be thy name,
thy kingdom come,
thy will be done,
on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our trespasses
as we forgive those
who trespass against us.
And lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil.
For thine is the kingdom,
the power and the glory,
for ever and ever. Amen.

#### The president breaks the consecrated bread for all to share:

We break this bread to share in the body of Christ. Though we are many, we are one body for we all share in one bread.

#### We say Agnus Dei:

Jesus Lamb of God, have mercy on us. Jesus, bearer of our sins, have mercy on us. Jesus, redeemer of the world, grant us peace.

#### The president invites all to receive Holy Communion:

Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. Blessed are those who are called to his supper.

Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof, but speak the word only and my soul shall be healed.

# All taking part online are encouraged to make their Spiritual Communion, using the following prayer:

Lord Jesus Christ, grant, that as the hem of your garment, touched in faith, healed the woman who could not touch your body, so the soul of your servant may be healed by faith in you, whom I cannot now sacramentally receive; through your tender mercy, who lives and reigns with the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit ever one God, world without end. Amen.

Baptised persons who are communicant members of Churches which subscribe to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity, and who are in good standing in their own church, may receive Holy Communion at this service.

#### The President prays the Post Communion prayer, then please STAND:

The Lord be with you. **And also with you.** 

May Christ who makes saints of sinners, who has transformed those we remember today, raise and strengthen you that you may transform the world;

♣ and the blessing of God almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be among you and remain with you always.

Amen.

The Mass is ended; go in the peace of Christ. **Thanks be to God**
