**Morning Prayer** is Tuesday-Friday at 0830 (Chancel) & **Evening Prayer** is Tuesday, Thursday and Friday at 1730 (Lady Chapel), using the *Common Worship Daily Prayer* app (please use the North Door if attending). If you would like to attend either service, please send the clergy a message so they know to unlock the door.

**Weekday Mass** is at 1000 on Tuesday, 1730 on Wednesday (both *Common Worship*) and 1000 on Thursday (*BCP*). All are quiet, simple celebrations lasting about 25-30 minutes and are available to attend in person or online; Tuesday and Thursday are in the Lady Chapel (southwest door) and Wednesday at the Adoration altar in the north aisle (north door).
