He will be Collated by the Bishop of Croydon and Inducted by the Archdeacon of Croydon as Vicar of Norbury and Thornton Heath on Monday 7 October in St Stephen's; do put those dates in your diary now.....

Choir development

We're restarting a 'front row' of children singing the treble line in the choir and already have a small group who are interested; they'll start at the beginning of September. We're advertising it in the local Primary Schools in the parish and through Sutton Music Trust; but if you know of a child (Year 3 upwards) who likes singing and might be interested, do let Antony know.

We're also looking for another Alto and two Tenor Choral Scholars; do spread the word and encourage applicants (and the posts for these are also out in schools!). *Equally, any gentlemen who sing Tenor or Bass, do have a word with Antony, who'd be delighted to hear from you.*

The final Choral Evensong of the term will be tonight at 1830 - do come along if you're able to, for a stunning end to the day!

Audio Visual update

The equipment for the new audio-visual system has arrived and it will be installed during the first week of August onwards. The updated sound system will be digital rather than analogue and will produce a much clearer sound and be more reliable. For streaming of services, there will be two mobile cameras around church, enabling opportunity to 'close in' at appropriate parts of the liturgy.

The cameras will be controlled via a mixing desk, laptop and iPad; with the associated software, the total cost is £26,000; donations to offset this amount will be gratefully received!
